Dear Principal,

I am please to confirm that the Emily Carr University of Art + Design will accept students from the FIS Institute for admission to our undergraduate degree programmes if their overall portfolio and academic scores qualify them for admission.

All applicants are ranked using a 100 point assessment system. Seventy (70) maximum points are allocated to the visual portfolio component of the assessment review and thirty (30) points are allocated to the academic component of the assessment. Students with a combined score of 65 out of 100 points are generally qualified for admission.


The minimum academic qualification for your students is completion of their high school diploma with a standing of C in five subject areas, including English, with at least two subjects at the A Level (or four at the Advanced Subsidiary Level). First year university transfer credit may be awarded for some A Level subjects. If the student's last three years of education instruction was not full-time and delivered in English then they will also have to complete the IELTS Academic test and score 6.5 with no band below 6.0.

The University will provide a conditional offer of admission for those students deemed "qualified" by an official representative of the University; this decision may be determined through an early review of both the portfolio and grade 11 or early term FIS examinations of the applicant.
