The University of Canterbury can provide a Conditional Offer of Place based on results from the FIS term examinations held in September.

On application, students with exceptional forecast results released in September, e.g. straight A's, may be granted a full offer in order to be eligible to enrol in February the following year. Applications with forecast results are considered on case-by-case basis. We have two annual intakes, in February and July.
