## Dear Principal

This letter is to confirm that students from FIS Institute, who are currently undertaking GCE - A Level and submit an application with preliminary results, will receive a conditional offer into the program of their choice. This is subject to satisfying the general entry requirements to the program, such as subject pre-requisites

Students from FIS Institute may receive an unconditional offer based on their predicted/forecast grades if their final results will not be available until immediately before or after their program commences and the applicant satisfies all requirements outlined below.

- The GCE-A Level predicted/forecast results must be **2 points** above the program entry grade requirement.
- Only predicted grades of B or higher will be accepted.
- The predicted/forecast grades must be signed off by the Registrar, Headmaster or Principal of the school.
- Students must satisfy the University's English Language Proficiency requirements with IELTS or an O Level in English or one of the other ways given here -<a href="http://ppl.app.uq.edu.au/content/3.40.14-english-language-proficiency-admission-and-concurrent-support#Procedures">http://ppl.app.uq.edu.au/content/3.40.14-english-language-proficiency-admission-and-concurrent-support#Procedures</a>
- The applicant is required to submit a certified copy of their complete and final academic transcript/ results as soon as it becomes available and prior to Census Date (31<sup>st</sup> of March for Semester 1 intake and 31<sup>st</sup> of August for Semester 2 intake).

Unconditional offers are issued to applicants satisfying the above requirements for all programs except those that have quotas or other admissions requirements such as the Bachelor of Dental Science and the Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery.

This conditional offer on preliminary results arrangement will be reviewed regularly, and will be withdrawn if students fall outside the requirements mentioned above.

Please refer to the University's Guide for International students which clearly details entry requirements for all programs.
