Dear Principal Lim Quee Seng,

In recognition of the high academic standard of teaching at FIS Institution Singapore, I am pleased to confirm your A Level students will be eligible to apply for entry to the University of South Australia on the basis of their predictive results.

A level students applying for a seat with the University of South Australia on the basis of predictive results will need to demonstrate they have met prerequisite subject requirements and achieved an overall score 2 points higher than the published requirement in their forecast results. On the proviso that there are no additional entry requirements to be met, unconditional offers will be issued in such instances.

Applicants who have achieved the minimum overall published score requirement with their forecast results (i.e. not two points higher) will be issued with conditional offers.

All applicants who are issued with offers to study with the University of South Australia on the basis of forecast results will be required to provide the International Office with a copy of their graduation certificate and final results on arrival in Adelaide.

All applications are assessed on an individual basis and there are a small number of quota programs offered by the University that do not grant admission on the basis of predictive results (high demand health science programs).
