We are delighted to be able to work with FIS Institute in order to assist your students to pursue their tertiary education at The University of Western Australia (UWA).

This letter is to confirm that students who are currently undertaking GCE A-levels at FIS Institute and submit an application to UWA will receive a conditional offer toward their chosen undergraduate course. Upon receipt of the official final A-level results and evidence that all conditions listed on the offer letter are satisfied (such as required entry scores, pre-requisites and English Proficiency requirement), we will update our system accordingly. Students will then be able to accept their offer and apply for their student visa.

However, where the final results will be unavailable prior to the commencement of the semester, UWA will accept forecast results from FIS Institute at least 2 points higher than the score published in our prospectus. In this scenario UWA will issue a provisional offer which will allow the students to accept their place and commence their studies without having to defer their course to the following semester. These students must provide their official final A-level results to the International Centre prior to the census date (31st March for the first semester or 31st August for the second semester).

Please note that the above conditions do not apply for competitive courses which have limited places such as Bachelor of Philosophy, Assured Pathway to Medicine and Dentistry and Assured Pathway to Juris Doctor. Please refer to our prospectus or our website for latest course information.
