The Principal of Furen International School,

I am writing to outline and confirm Kansas State University's admission policy for FIS students in GCE curricula.

As discussed previously, Kansas State does not require any specific subjects for admission. We also do not require the completion of AS- or A-levels for admission.

Students are welcome to apply to Kansas State with their O-level internal grades or final results from their FIS Graduation Examination in August. If students submit FIS internal grades, we can grant admission based on those. We would then require students to submit copies of their final results in their GCE O-level examinations to our office once they are released.

For admission to most programs at Kansas State, students are required to have a minimum of 2.5 out of 4.0 GPA (Grade Point Average). For programs in Engineering, Architecture, or Interior Design, students are required to have a minimum of 3.0 out of 4.0 GPA. The GCE curriculum is weighted, and would be converted according to the scale below:

GCE Grade	U.S. Grade	GPA Equivalent
A	A	4.0
B	A	4.0
C	B	3.0
D	C	2.0
