Furen International School A Level students will be considered for admission into a Bachelor's degree program at The University of Tulsa in Oklahoma in the United States based on their year 10 and 11 results and their A Level internal results in their FIS Graduation Examinations in August. These students who are offered a placement of admission into Tulsa after a review of their FIS internal grades will need to submit their official GCE A Level exam results before enrollment or when they are released by Cambridge.

The University of Tulsa will award a scholarship of \$16,000 per year to one outstanding FIS student.

Students who are admitted to The University of Tulsa will have a B average or higher in their GCE O Level results, or equivalent. For FIS students who wish to apply to Tulsa with their internal results, they must have grades of CCC or higher in 3 A Level subjects in their FIS Graduation Examinations in August. Students who fall slightly below this standard for admission may also be considered, however for these students, there would be no guarantee of admission.

Students with a grade of A on the GCE O Level English Language exam will be considered for waiver of the TOEFL/IELTS requirement. Students who are not granted a waiver must provide an IELTS score of 6.0 in their overall band with no individual bands below 6.0.

The University of Tulsa looks forward to welcoming FIS students to the University and is happy to award our international scholarship to one outstanding FIS student.
