Qualifications for FIS Students:

1. Applicants must complete at least 5 GCE O'Level subjects together with 3 AS' or A' Level subjects (8 subjects in total with Grade A – C).
2. Applicants can submit the Grade Report of Year 10 – 13 and GCE O'Level and AS' or A' Level Certificate.
3. FIS applicants must submit a TOEFL (iBT) score of at least 79 with Writing 25 or IELTS (Academic band) score of at least 6.0 with Writing 6.0.

Remark:

If FIS students apply to MUC while they await their Certificates from Cambridge, they are allowed to first submit their FIS internal grades from their school graduation examination in August. Following which they will be required to submit their Cambridge Certificates before the MUC announcement date, and in the case of FIS students, it will be Trimester 3.

Required documents:

1. Official high school transcript and Certificate
2. Official score report of either TOEFL or IELTS
3. Official score report of SAT – Math (if any)
4. Two letters of recommendation from school
5. Statement of Purpose (250 words at least)
6. Financial Statement of Personal or Family Support
7. Medical Certificate
8. Online application form
9. 3 photos

Application deadline:

- Trimester 1 (September) - The middle of July
- Trimester 2 (January) - The middle of October
- Trimester 3 (April) - The middle of January
