Final-year FIS students interested in applying to Loyola University Chicago will need to meet all requirements for International Freshman Admission. Admission requirements are outlined on our website:

In addition, FIS counseling staff will need to submit the student's O-Level results, any marks earned for their A1 year (or AS Level), and A-Level internal marks, at the time of application. Their final, official GCE A-Level results must be submitted in August just prior to matriculating to Loyola, once the students have taken their final exams.

By applying to Loyola University Chicago with an official SAT or ACT score, applicants from FIS will also receive automatic consideration for Loyola's Freshman Merit Scholarships. If a merit scholarship is granted, it will be announced in the student's letter of admission.
